



Morris Animal Foundation - Pilot Studies - 2010

- Pilot studies must meet the following criteria:

- Budget cannot exceed \$10,800 (\$10,000 plus 8 percent for indirect costs)

- Studies cannot exceed one year

- Applicants must submit using MAF's online form

- All investigators are eligible to apply—new investigators are particularly encouraged

- An investigator can serve as principal investigator (PI) or co-investigator on only ONE

- (1) MAF pilot study per year.

You *are not* eligible to apply as the PI of an MAF pilot study if you currently (at the time of submitting the application) have extramural funding exceeding \$20,000. This does not apply to any co-investigators on the study. A pending proposal at or exceeding this budget with MAF or another funding agency is acceptable.

The PI on an MAF pilot study does not need to have full-time faculty status at his or her institution. Residents are eligible to apply for this award.

- Evaluation criteria: Proposals are evaluated based on their [relevance to MAF](#), scientific merit, innovativeness of the research idea(s), and adherence to MAF's [Health Study Policy](#).
