At Morris Animal Foundation, we work every day to improve and protect the health of animals through scientific innovation, education and inspiration. We are committed to fighting animal diseases worldwide in species ranging from cats and dogs to horses and alpacas; amphibians and wildcats to anteaters and elephants.

For 70 years, our investment in research has yielded lifesaving vaccines, new treatments for critical diseases, superior screening tests and advanced diagnostic tools.

With every study we fund – more than 2,600 to date – we strive to advance the science of veterinary medicine, honoring the founding principles of Dr. Mark L. Morris Sr. to benefit animals worldwide.





We conduct groundbreaking work in canine infectious diseases, including studies that led to the development of the parvovirus vaccine, saving the lives of thousands of dogs every year.



We find solutions for serious health problems in cats, such as injection-site sarcoma, feline infectious peritonitis and kidney disease, and we laid the groundwork for the first feline leukemia vaccine.



We tackle health problems in horses including melanoma, foal pneumonia and laminitis. We funded research that identified the causative agent for Potomac horse fever.



In addition to comprehensive wildlife health studies, we respond to urgent events affecting wildlife, such as natural disasters and emerging diseases, through our Betty White Wildlife Rapid Response Fund.

Golden Retriever Lifetime Study

Launched in 2012, the Golden Retriever
Lifetime Study is the first Morris Animal
Foundation-funded study conceived,
designed and run by the Foundation and its
partners. The study examines epidemiology
and the long-term effects of nutrition,
environment, lifestyle and genetics on
health and the development of cancer and
other major diseases in dogs.

The Golden Retriever Lifetime Study is the largest prospective study ever undertaken in veterinary medicine, gathering information on 3,000+ golden retrievers throughout their entire lives.
