Provide day to day support for study operations for the Golden Retriever Lifetime Study

The Golden Retriever Lifetime Study is the largest and most comprehensive prospective study ever undertaken in veterinary medicine. The Study, which was launched in 2012 and follows over 3,000 dogs throughout their lifetime, is funded and managed by the Morris Animal Foundation. The goal of the Study is to identify risk factors associated with development of cancer and other major diseases in dogs.

The Foundation has an exciting opportunity for a Veterinary Research Assistant, who will be part of the Golden Retriever Lifetime Study team that supports day to day study operations.

The primary duties of this job include:

- Engaging with participating dog owners and veterinarians by phone and email, to field study questions and requests, and to provide appointment and other reminders;
- Fulfilling scheduled daily shipments of study kits to participating dog owners and/or veterinarians, and responding to unscheduled requests as needed;
- Assisting Operations team with study supply inventory, including data entry and supply staging;
- Investigating, locating and retrieving tissue specimens from clinical laboratories, for use in pathology confirmation and future research studies;
- Maintaining study databases and tracking spreadsheets;
- Other duties as assigned.

Required Experience:

This position requires a bachelor's degree in a life science discipline with direct experience in customer service, or four or more years of experience as a veterinary technician.

- Team-oriented worker who is able to flexibly adapt in a dynamic research environment;
- Able to follow standard operating procedures and checklists with high accuracy;
- Able to quickly learn and use new software and databases;
