

Position Title: Senior Software Developer

Position Summary: This position is responsible for hands-on development of web-based software and databases for Morris Animal Foundation and the Golden Retriever Lifetime Study using Drupal 8, PHP, SQL and other tools as appropriate.

The Golden Retriever Lifetime Study is one of the largest, most comprehensive prospective canine health studies in the United States. The Study's purpose is to identify the nutritional, environmental, lifestyle and genetic risk factors for cancer and other diseases in dogs. Each year, with the help of veterinarians and dog owners, the Foundation collects health, environmental and behavioral data on 3,000+ enrolled golden retrievers.

Position Essential Functions

- WEB APPLICATION DEVELOPMENT: Implement critical user interfaces for scientific data management for use in the Golden Retriever Lifetime Study and other animal-health related research projects. This work is being done primarily in Drupal 8.
- SOFTWARE DEVELOPMENT: Responsible for designing, writing and testing software for data processing and database maintenance, typically in PHP 7.
- RELATIONAL DATABASE IMPLEMENTATION: Responsible for implementing, maintaining and evolving relational databases in support of the Golden Retriever Lifetime Study. This will involve the implementation of new databases as well as migrating existing databases from MS Access to MySQL.
- ANALYSIS AND DESIGN: Participate, along with others on the GRLS project, in the
 analysis and design work for both the database and user interface development.
 This will involve standard domain and workflow analysis, along with interface mockups and user reviews.



Position Requirements

- Minimum 8 years of experience developing web applications using Drupal with a relational database backend.
- Minimum 1 year of experience developing web applications using Drupal 8.
- Minimum 5 years of experience developing software in PHP and SQL.
- Minimum 3 years of experience using git.
- Experience with automated testing tools.
- Excellent organizational, interpersonal, verbal and written English communication skills.
- Knowledgeable about dogs, with passion and empathy for companion animals and their owners, and a dedication to the Foundation's mission.
- Must love animals!
